Dear Parents/carers,

Your child is now due their Teenage vaccinations. These are vaccinations to protect against **Tetanus, Diphtheria, Polio** (Td/IPV) and **Meningitis** (Men ACWY).

Your child may have received these vaccines as an infant, they are now due their final booster vaccinations to be fully protected.

The vaccination session in your child's school is on **2<sup>nd</sup> May**. The consent form must be completed by **29<sup>th</sup> April** for your child to have the vaccine at the school session. If you miss this date, catch up opportunities are available either in school or at Community Clinics. Please contact our service before contacting your GP.

We regularly send reminders to those we have not received contact from to ensure children do not miss their opportunity for vaccination.

### **Frequently Asked questions**

**Q: How do I know if my child is due these vaccinations?**

A: Check your NHS app or contact your GP surgery.

**Q: What treatments would affect my child's immune system?**

A: This would be treatment such as chemotherapy or on antiviral treatment.

**Q: How do I know if my child has a bleeding disorder?**

A: A confirmed diagnoses from GP/hospital doctor of a condition where the blood does not clot quickly (not including nosebleeds).

**Q: What are the ingredients in the vaccine?**

**Q: How would I know if my child has a bleeding disorder?**
